

NVCH 2021 Scholarship Program Information

March 1, 2021

APPLICATION DEADLINE: All application materials must be submitted by: Wednesday, March 31, 2021, 5pm. Late applications will not be considered.

Purpose: Provide a scholarship of \$500 for continuing education to four transitional adult youths, age 17-24 years.

- Community college
- Undergraduate and graduate degrees
- Vocational and certificate programs
- Adult and continuing education

Award: Four (4) individuals will each be awarded a non-renewable scholarship selected by the NVCH Scholarship Committee.

Eligibility:

- 1. Must be a resident at a NVCH property*.
- 2. Graduating Senior in high school, or older
- 3. 2.5 GPA or higher for high school, college or university students
- 4. High school applicants must be graduating from high school in May/June 2021
- 5. Applicant must demonstrate involvement within the school and community.
- 6. Scholarship funds will be distributed when proof of enrollment is provided from the college/university/vocational or technical institution you intend to enroll in **Fall 2021**.

Expenses:

These scholarships are designated for costs directly related to your educational pursuits such as tuition, books, school materials, a computer, mileage, parking permits or transit passes to/from school, class-time childcare, etc.

Personal expenses are not allowable scholarship expenses and should not be included (ex: food, rent, utilities, fines/tickets, vehicle repair/purchase, personal electronics (TV's, phones, video game systems, furniture, etc.)

Application: Please send a single email with the following documents saved in a pdf format to: nvch@nvch.org

- 1. Scholarship application
- 2. Copy of transcript (high school, college or university applicants)
- 3. Essay
- 4. Two (2) letters of recommendations.

Entry Requirements: Essays and recommendation letters **must be typed**, double-spaced, in 12-point Times New Roman or an equivalent font, with numbered pages and one-inch margins.

Letters of Recommendations: Below are some possible themes which may assist your references in crafting their letter. Please do not submit letters from a relative:

- 1. Describe your relationship to the applicant. How long have you know the applicant?
- 2. In what ways has the applicant been working towards the educational and professional goals they have expressed during the time that you have known them? What is special about this applicant and their goals?

- 3. In your opinion, how would the applicant benefit from a scholarship award?
- 4. What factors in the applicant's background or experience will most contribute to their success in their chosen field? Comment on areas in which the applicant excels and areas in which they have room to grow.
